Purpose

The Dr. Patrick and Kathleen Murtha President's Scholarship Fund was created to advance the commitment of quality and service excellence while honoring the dedication of personal growth and development of St. Joseph Health System's associates through their commitment of continuing education.

Awards

A \$1,000 scholarship will be awarded each year in May.

Eligibility

- A full-time SJHS associate with a minimum of three years employment history. Must be in good standing with no written disciplinary actions in the past twelve months.
- Currently enrolled in an accredited university or college with a minimum of six credit hours pursuing an undergraduate degree in a clinical or allied health care profession.
- Must have completed at least one semester of studies with an overall GPA of 3.0.
- Must submit a letter of recommendation from their immediate Supervisor.

Guidelines

- The scholarship award will be applied toward tuition, fees or books and sent to the school as designated by the scholarship recipient.
- If a recipient withdraws from school while the award is in effect, a request will be made for the return of funds.
- Application, school transcripts and other supporting documentation must be received in the Foundation Office by April 16, 2012.
- Selection of recipient will be made May 1, 2012 with notifications by mail immediately following.
- Attendance at the annual award celebration.
